Eagle Scout Daniel Green greeted the Commission and provided a hand out to the Commissioners.

Mr. Green summarized his proposal for the LH on the hill project. Mr. Green suggested pavers or cement in an effort to secure the LH to avoid vandalism and it being tampered with.

Pavers are \$1 per sq/ft. He doesn't have a budget for the project at this point.

Eagle scout hopes to be able to raise some funds for project but nothing definite. Chair Cooper suggested coming to the next meeting with a little more detailed analyse.

This presentation detailed the playground upgrades and slope upgrades. He indicated they would be removing all the play panel and play equipment and replace them. Will be removing rectangular sandbox and move it closer to the seating area. It will also elevated sand play area. Wood chips are being removed and replaced with rubberized surface and colored surfacing near volleyball courts. Replacing picnic tables. Installing ADA compliant drinking fountain. They will be removing 15 Eucalyptus trees. Will be planting California pepper trees, installing new irrigation, new fencing, and ground cover. Bid authorization going to City Council 2nd week in January.

Mr. Whittaker of Laguna Hills greeted the Commission. He stated that the trees provide a touch of a natural environment and provides a nice visual buffer from view of the apartments. Would appreciate if we can save as many trees as possible and when we plant new trees if we can plant large gallon trees to prevent looking at dwarf trees.

Angela Jackson of Laguna Hills greeted and thanked the Commission for listening to her previous comments. She recommended a dog area and installing a basketball court instead of volleyball court. Beverly Jackson greeted the Commission and requested basketball court and dog park.
